


Welcome to Ripon, WI!

Ripon is a historic town snuggled right up to campus! With a brewery, ice cream shops, a 140-acre prairie, and a beautifully restored mill and mill pond, Ripon is full of fun things to do!

The wooded campus hosts numerous athletic facilities, art museums, dining options, meeting spaces, and so much more. Ceresco Prairie also includes miles of prairie and wooded trails for both walking and biking.

Ripon is just 1.5 hours northwest of Milwaukee and about 30 minutes from the Lake Winnebago towns of Oshkosh and Fond du Lac.
